**Resolution for Change in Membership of the Commission on Student Affairs**

WHEREAS, the Commission on Student Affairs is charged "to study, formulate, and recommend to University Council policies and procedures affecting graduate and undergraduate student life and morale. Areas for consideration include: student relations with peers, staff, faculty, administrators, alumni, and the community; student organizations, social life, and recreation; employment, placement, and counseling; residential life, health, safety, and quality of student related services; and other matters affecting student life." (University Council Constitution and Bylaws, Article VII, Section 14) and,

WHEREAS, the purpose of the United Council of Fraternities and Sororities is to unify the undergraduate branches of fraternities and sororities with an established religious/faith based, cultural/ethnic, or service related focus at Virginia Tech and the surrounding communities. In addition UCFS will exist to encourage and foster the networking, collaboration and uplift of its member organizations and

WHEREAS, the United Council of Fraternities and Sororities is a registered University Chartered Student Organization that does not currently hold a seat on the Commission on Student Affairs, and

WHEREAS, the United Council of Fraternities and Sororities is the acting umbrella organization representing Greek organizations that are religion/faith, culture/ethnicity, and/or service based, and

WHEREAS, the Interfraternity Council, Panhellenic Council, and National Pan-Hellenic Council currently hold seats on the Commission on Student Affairs, and the United Council of Fraternities and Sororities should be offered an equal opportunity to hold a seat, and

WHEREAS, the Asian American Student Union, Hillel, and Latin Association for Student Organizations are not underneath the United Council of Fraternities and Sororities, nor is the United Council of Fraternities and Sororities underneath the Asian American Student Union, the Hillel, and Latin Association for Student Organizations, therefore they cannot be a voice for the religion/faith, culture/ethnicity, and/or service Greek organizations.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the membership of the Commission on Student Affairs should be changed to reflect greater efficiency and equity. (Those representatives denoted by an \* are proposed new members.)
