**Resolution Revising the Membership of the Commission on Student Affairs**

WHEREAS, the Commission on Student Affairs (CSA) is charged “to study, formulate, and recommend to University Council policies and procedures affecting graduate and undergraduate student life and morale. Areas for consideration include: student relations with peers, staff, faculty, administrators, alumni, and the community; student organizations, social life, and recreation; employment, placement, and counseling; residential life, health, safety, and quality of student related services; and other matters affecting student life.” And,

WHEREAS, the membership of CSA is the largest of any Commission at Virginia Tech and,

WHEREAS, currently the membership of CSA includes all Assistant Vice President(s) of Student Affairs and all Associate Vice President(s) of Student Affairs and,

WHEREAS, the current membership of CSA includes the Vice President and Dean for Graduate Education and not the Vice President and Dean for Undergraduate Education and,

WHEREAS, the current membership of CSA includes three (3) representative from the faculty elected by Faculty Senate and only one is filled for the 2009-2010 academic year and,

WHEREAS, A/P faculty and Staff Senate only currently have one (1) representative each

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the membership of the Commission of Student Affairs be revised to reduce overlap between seats, provide continuity between years, and provide equal representation from faculty, A/P faculty and staff. The membership will be changed to meet these goals by:

1. Streamlining the Ex. Officio positions to eliminate overlap
  - Remove the Associate Vice President for Academic Support Services
  - Replace Associate Provost for Undergraduate Education with Vice President & Dean for Undergraduate Education
  - Add the Dean of Students as Ex. Officio position
2. Eliminate the two Division of Student Affairs Representatives (now covered under the Ex. Officio positions)
3. Reduce the number of representatives from Faculty Senate from three (3) faculty representatives to one (1) faculty representative elected by the Faculty Senate

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the section of the University Council Bylaws, addressing Commission on Student Affairs Membership be changed accordingly.
