Whereas, the Commission on Student Affairs has grown in size over the years to be the largest Commission in the governance system (38 members, with the other Commissions ranging in size from 17 to 33 members), and

Whereas, the major source of such growth has been a practice of adding a seat on the Commission whenever a Registered Student Organization became a Chartered Student organization, and

Whereas, such a practice usually adds an undergraduate student seat and thereby continually shrinks the proportionate representation of graduate students on the Commission, and

Whereas, the Commission should be more efficient through reduced size and yet maintain a diverse and appropriate representation;

Therefore Be It Resolved that the membership of the Commission of the Commission on Student Affairs be revised in Section III-H of the Bylaws of the University Council to be as follows:

Vice President for Student Affairs\*

Vice President and Dean for Graduate Education\*

Vice President and Dean for Undergraduate Education\*

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Two A/P faculty from the Division of Student Affairs (appointed by the Vice President for Student Affairs for three-year terms)

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One representative elected by the Faculty Senate (three-year term)

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One non-ex officio A/P faculty representative elected by CAPFA: general administration, academic support, student affairs, Extension (three-year term)

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One staff senator elected by the Staff Senate (three-year term)

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All that follow are one-year terms

Vice President of Membership, Graduate Student Assembly  
Doctoral candidate elected by Graduate Student Assembly  
Masters candidate elected by Graduate Student Assembly  
President, Student Government Association  
Cadet Colonel of the Corps of Cadets  
Senior Class President  
Junior Class President  
President, Black Organizations Council  
President, Council of International Students  
Representative of the Greek Councils (chosen by the Director of Fraternity and Sorority Life)  
President, Residence Hall Federation  
President, Asian American Student Union  
President, Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, and Transgender Alliance  
Graduate Representative to the Board of Visitors  
Undergraduate Representative to the Board of Visitors  
President, Latino Association of Student Organizations  
President, Jewish Student Union
