WHEREAS, President Sands maintained that legal and compliance risks arising from new federal regulatory requirements, coupled with the Board of Visitors’ DEI resolution passed on March 25, 2025, created an exigent circumstance requiring the university leadership to act quickly to eliminate or adjust a number of university programs and services, including some changes to academic programs; and

WHEREAS, as a result, President Sands informed University Council Cabinet of university action taken to suspend the requirement to fulfill Pathways Core Concept 7: Critical Analysis of Identity and Equity in the United States for all current students; and

WHEREAS, on September 8, 2025, University Council Cabinet approved a motion to affirm the administration’s decision to suspend Pathways Core Concept 7 and associated resolutions and policies; and

WHEREAS, on October 1, 2025, Pathways Core Concept 7 was suspended, and the requirement was fulfilled for all students’ DARS; and

WHEREAS, Pathways Core Concept 7 was created and approved by faculty through shared governance according to the following policies and resolutions: [PPM 299](#): Addressing Intersectional Diversity in Pathways Curriculum and accompanying [Resolution CEOD 2015-16C](#), PPM 290-Revision 1: Resolution to Revise Pathways General Education Curriculum and accompanying [Resolution CUSP 2016-17G](#) (such that the original PPM 290 issued April 6, 2015, is in effect); and

WHEREAS, regrettably, the Undergraduate Curriculum Committee on General Education, the appropriate faculty committee, was not consulted; and

WHEREAS, the four-year assessment cycle for Pathways was developed by UCCGE and includes two years of data collection, one year of data analysis, and one year of action on those results; and

WHEREAS, year 3 of that cycle, which is the upcoming academic year (AY 2026-27), calls for a thorough review of the program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the UCCGE, in collaboration with faculty and the university community and utilizing the process of shared governance in order to return responsibility for the curriculum to the faculty, will use year three of the Pathways review cycle (AY 2026-27) to determine how to revise the Pathways program, including Core Concept 7, in such manner that it provides meaningful contribution to students' education and does not pose a legal risk; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that UCCGE and CUSP reaffirms the Principles of Community and reaffirms that Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University is an institution that highly values diversity and fosters an inclusive environment, encouraging a culture of opportunity for all, which immensely enriches our campus, and is committed to providing every student an education that is free from discrimination.
