1. Approval of agenda **B. Hicok**

2. Approval of Feb. 21 2020 minutes **B. Hicok**
Minutes were unanimously approved.

3. 2nd reading of CFA2019-20C (Resolution on FHB Chapter 5 revision) **B. Hicok**
Resolution CFA2019-20C passed unanimously.

A motion passed unanimously committing the Commission on Faculty Affairs to review, and if necessary, propose changes to the language in the Faculty Handbook that addresses the composition and appointment of departmental evaluation and review committees. In addition, the commission committed to convening and working the appropriate faculty to identify a label to replace “non tenure track” in the Faculty Handbook.

4. 1st reading of CFA2019-20D **B. Hicok**
(Resolution to Change the Terms of Service for Faculty, Students, and Staff on University Council and Commissions)

Commission members discussed the value of changing or maintaining the policy of having the vice president of the faculty senate automatically serve as chair of the Commission of Faculty Affairs. As presented, the resolution allows for the faculty senate vice president to be *elected* as chair of the CFA. Term limits create leadership opportunities for new and different colleagues to serve in governance. Staff senate discussed the resolution and prefers to maintain the leadership structure as it is. The impact of this resolution on other commissions and the emerging A/P senate. The resolution will continue to be reviewed.
