## **Old Business**

## <u>Beyond Boundaries Scholarship</u> update-Holli Gardner

- \$3095 raised so there will be match from the university

A/P Faculty Professional Development Leave Working Group-Susan Short, Marlena Lester

- Data evaluation slides
- The survey data are being evaluated currently with the results from the the AP faculty senators and those who were asked to complete from our own senators

- The survey was not designed to distribute to all A/P Faculty classified individuals
- The survey asked about the different options for professional development and the top three choices were degree/certificate completion, a global experience, and developing a special proposal and/or program
- Most respondents choose a time for the professional development to be one month, then 3 months, and evenly distributed though other options
- Respondents also shared how professional development would benefit them and the university
- Respondents would like to have 100% salary compensation for any professional development leave

#### New Business

Honorific Awards for Faculty-Amanda Covey

- <u>Presentation Slides</u>
- The faculty support and recognition specialist is a new role at the university to assist with honorific awards
- Background:
  - Association of American Universities (AAU)-VT strives to become a member
    - Composed of America's leading private and public research universities and membership must be earned
    - They determine many rankings for universities
  - National Research Council (NRC)-was created by the National Academies and they collect specific information on institutions and the awards won
    - They created a list in 2006 of prestigious awards, but it has not been updated since then
    - The data that is created is used by the AAU to determine memberships
- Many of our current faculty are underawarded than their peers at other universities and are competitive for the awards, but they are not being nominated
- ICTAS's mission is to move faculty and research forward and a dedicated effort was created to increase our award potential (hence Amanda's new position)
- Three strategies to improve our representation

- Identify targets
  - Utilizing Academic Analytics database to identify potential awards and faculty who may be eligible for specific awards
  - Identify award paths for early-career faculty and target specific awards
  - Identify awards being won by your peers
- Share Information
  - Maintain <u>a website</u> to share resources
  - Connect with other peer institutions
  - Meet with stakeholders within the university to align efforts
- Support Nominations
  - Create a centralized point of management for limited submission awards
  - Assist with nomination packets
  - Provide guidance on creating packet materials
  - Being a university level liaison to particular societies and associations
- What have we learned?
  - Academic Analytics does have its limitations
  - NRC ranked awards listing are currently outdated and not comprehensive
  - Some faculty are competitive, but are missing key requirements (like memberships)
  - Faculty are humble and/or time restricted and do not have time to pursue them
- What can departments do?
  - Maintain faculty memberships
  - Review the Honorifics <u>website</u>
  - Please share any faculty who have won awards
  - Make sure that websites are current and include CVs if possible
  - Nominate your peers
  - Encourage faculty to apply to one they are eligible for
  - Create an "awards culture" in your departments that value this endeavor
- Has there been discussions on assistance with funding for memberships so that faculty are eligible? Yes! We are trying to create university level resources, but also making sure that departments are aware so they can assist too
- What can we do to get VT on the AAU list? This new position is the first step and then continue to work with Amanda to nominate faculty awards; more awards will mean more recognition and improved ability to be on the AAU list

- What is the timeline for working with Amanda for a particular award? one month is good, but the more time the faculty member allows is better
- Do you collaborate with Academic Resource Management office tracking these metrics? I am not aware of the group: the group is under Jeff Earley and that unit does a large amount of data tracking
- Amanda has also worked with members of the library

## Job Architecture Update-Evans Lusuli

- Job Architecture 101
- No significant new information is available at this time; many projects are still in process including the Job Architecture and salary structure
- We continue to get input from senior level management and leadership on all components
- There is end user testing also being done
- The website is up to date with the status
- Next month will be a much more in depth update
- The end of the project is currently in sight
