- e. VT – Carilion School of Medicine – Move to a new building and renovate the old building.
- f. Innovation Campus – Scheduled completion is late fall 2024.
- g. Life, Health, Safety, Accessibility, and Code Compliance – Priority 1 Derring Steps elevators 45% complete, Liza – Priority 2 Green Link is under design.
- h. Building Improvements – Lane Stadium Hokie stone repairs are on schedule to be finished before football season. Football Locker Room Construction is 25% complete. The Locker Room is scheduled to be completed before football season.
- i. Undergraduate Science Lab and War Memorial are scheduled to be completed in July.
- j. Hitt Hall – Scheduled completion this summer.
- k. Livestock & Poultry Research Facilities – Phase 1, bid package #5
- l. Multi-modal Transit Facility- Construction is 80% complete and should be complete this summer. Busses will do time checks on this loop and won't be sitting along campus. This should make the bus routes more efficient.
