Kayla Dean called the meeting to order at 11AM. A quorum was present.

1. Adoption of Agenda

A motion was made and seconded to adopt the agenda. The motion carried.

2. Approval of Minutes of September 10, 2024

3. Unfinished Business

There was no unfinished business.

4. New Business

Pam Tate provided an update on payroll deduction options for parking permits, launching in January. New salaried employees will have the option to pro-rate and enroll in payroll deduction for annual permits within their first 30 days, with monthly deductions continuing until the next permit cycle.

This option will not apply to wage employees, who will still receive a 30-day free permit to bridge the gap before their first paycheck.

Carrie Cox explained that the 30-day free permit helps avoid financial strain on new employees, while payroll deductions simplify payment and reduce the tendency to avoid paying as long as possible.

The program's effectiveness will be monitored and could extend to the Innovation Campus in the future.

7. Other Items

AJ Prussin inquired about designated parking areas for Uber/Lyft drivers. Pam Tate explained that a designated area had been tried previously, but it was ineffective as drivers continued to park outside the designated spaces.
