They will be given two opportunities to pass the quiz. If they pass, their first ticket is waived.

The program will not be advertised until early Spring semester - the hope is to run a news story highlighting the program's success, but currently it is in the soft launch phase.

7. Other Items

Hollis Whittman brought up concerns over ADA parking not being enforced, often as loading zones. Carrie encouraged people to call in violations so they can be attended to quickly, and report areas that may often be used improperly.
