There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 5:00 p.m.

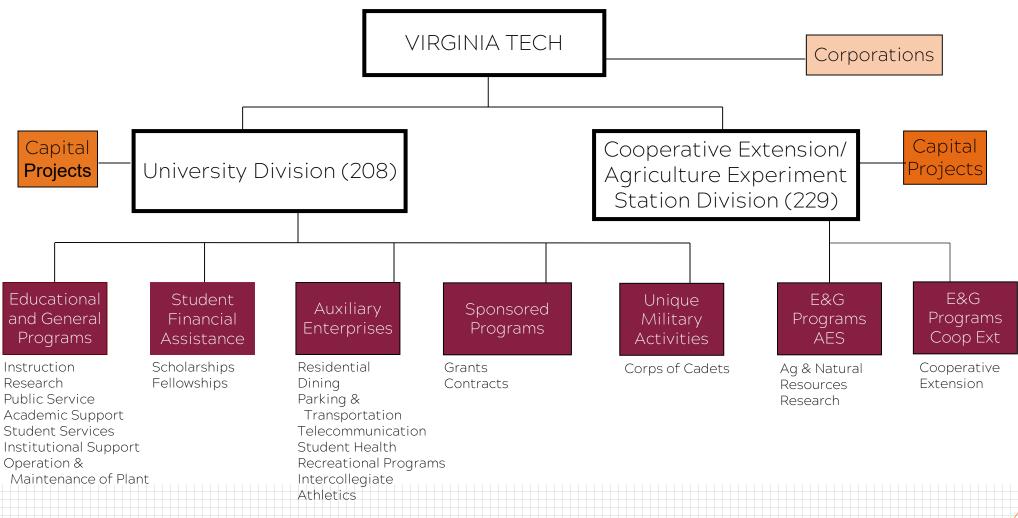

Program Structure





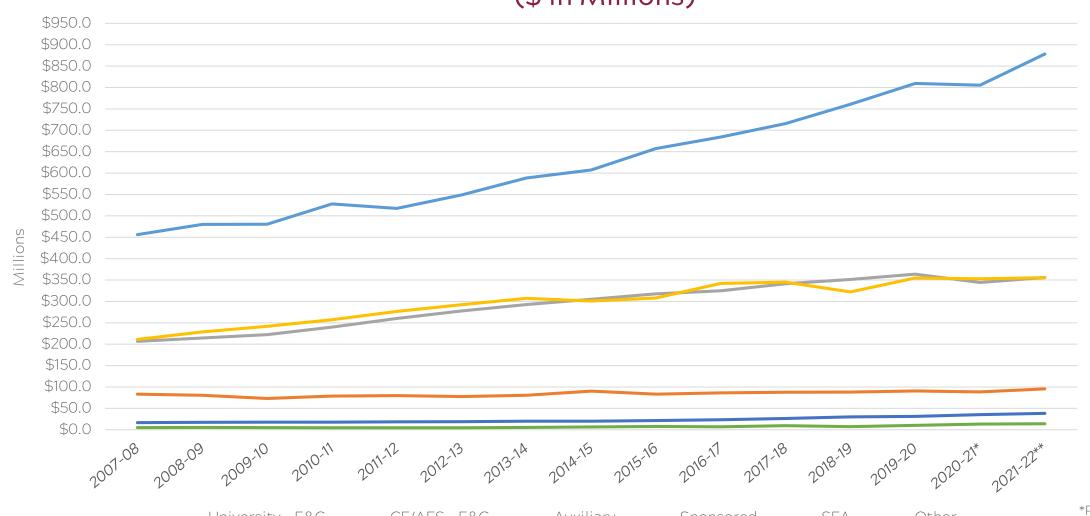

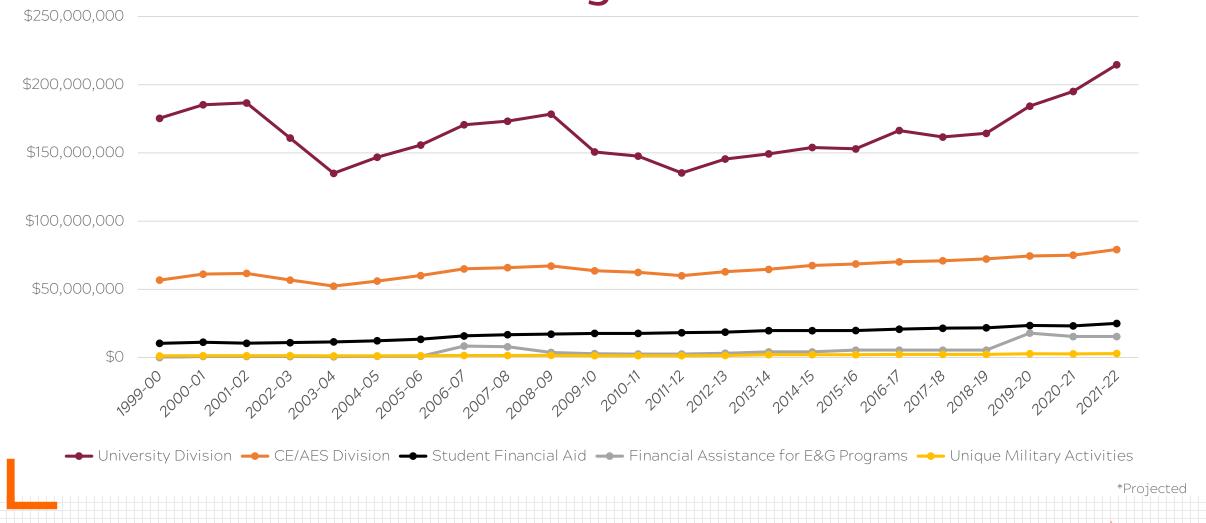


2021-22 Operating Budget Trend by Component (\$ in Millions)
